A TASTE OF LESSON 1

Place value of digits up to thousands

By the end of the lesson, the learner should be able to: a) state the place value of each digit in a number up to 9,999; b) write a number from its place value chart

Finding the place value of each digit in 4,538

Write 4,538 in a place value chart: Thousands 4 | Hundreds 5 | Tens 3 | Ones 8.

The 4 sits in the thousands place, so its place value is thousands. The 5 is in the hundreds place, the 3 in the tens place and the 8 in the ones place.
